

With pleasure today we welcome Dr. David A. Renwick. A native of Scotland, David earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Applied Math from the University of St. Andrews ('74), Master of Divinity from Gordon-Conwell Seminary ('77), and Doctor of Philosophy from Union Seminary in Virginia ('87).

David met his wife, Currie, a native of Gainesville, Georgia, in 1971-72, while she was studying at St Andrews as a "Junior Year Abroad" student from Tulane University. Currie is a librarian, currently working at Key Elementary school in the D. C. city school system.

The Renwick's have three adult children: Lalla, a teacher in Washington, DC (husband, Diego, Lucy 4 yrs; Mateo 1); Charlie (wife, Lauren; sons Maclean, 8; James, 6; Eleanor 4), a CPA in Covington, LA; and Mairi, a PCUSA minister, Director of Admissions, Union Seminary, Richmond, VA.

The Renwicks have served churches in Labrador, Canada; Appomattox County, Virginia; San Antonio, Texas; Lexington, Kentucky, and Spartanburg, South Carolina. In 2011 David received a call to become Senior Pastor at The National Presbyterian Church, Washington, DC.
