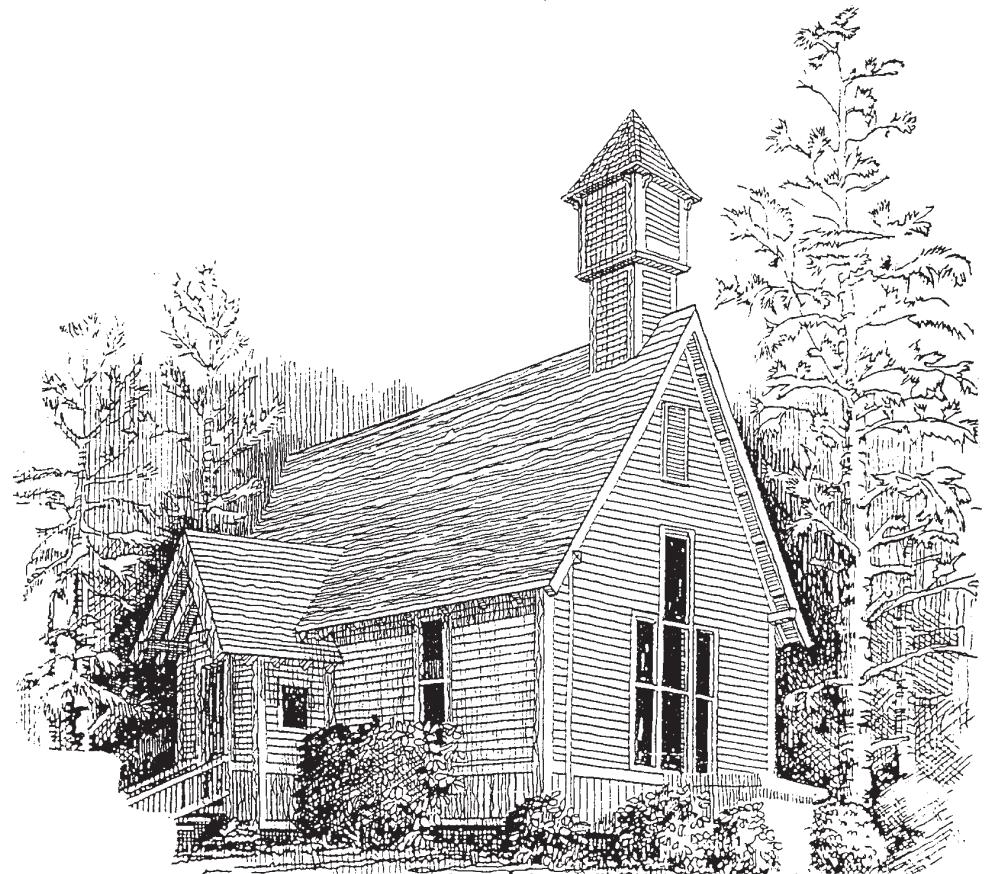
Thursday Morning Bible Study

This week we welcome Dr. Edwin G. Hurley and his wife Gayle.

Dr. Edwin G. Hurley, Ed is the Senior Pastor of the South Highland Presbyterian Church, Birmingham, Alabama. Ed is in his 19th year of service at SHPC. SHPC is an historic congregation, founded in 1888, located near downtown Birmingham, seeking to help all become “Fully Alive with the Passion of Christ.”

Ed grew up in El Dorado, Arkansas. He graduated from McCallie School, Chattanooga, Tennessee. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Vanderbilt University with a double major in history and English, his Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary, his Doctor of Ministry from Fuller Theological Seminary. Ed did graduate study at New College, the University of Edinburgh as recipient of the Graduate Study Fellowship for Parish Ministry Award from Princeton Theological Seminary.

Ed is active in the Presbytery of Sheppards & Lapsley. He has served on the Committee on Ministry, as Chair of the Permanent Judicial Commission, currently on the Executive Council, and as a commissioner to General Assembly. He previously served as Chair of the Board of the Outreach Foundation of the Presbyterian Church, which coordinates international mission work, with whom he has traveled to Syria, Lebanon, India, China, Mozambique, and Zimbabwe. He serves on the Advisory Board of Beeson Divinity School, Samford University, and Alumni Council of Princeton Theological Seminary.

Dr. Hurley has served churches in Tulsa, Oklahoma; Monroe, Louisiana; and Bowling Green, Kentucky. Ed and Gayle have three children.
