Dr. David Alistair Renwick

With pleasure today we welcome Dr. David Alistair Renwick and his wife Currie.

Born in Malaysia, and reared in Edinburgh, Scotland, Dr. Renwick earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Applied Math from the University of St. Andrews, Master of Divinity from Gordon-Conwell Seminary, and Doctor of Philosophy in New Testament Studies from Union Presbyterian Seminary.

Dr. Renwick met his wife, Currie, a native of Gainesville, Georgia, while she was studying at St Andrews as a "Junior Year Abroad" student from Tulane University. Currie retired this June a school librarian in the Washington DC public schools.

The Renwicks have three adult children: Lalla, a teacher in Washington, DC (husband, Diego; two children: Lucy and Mateo); Charlie, a CPA in Covington, LA (wife, Lauren; three children: Maclean, James, Eleanor); and Mairi, an ordained Presbyterian minister, Chaplain at Union Presbyterian Seminary, Richmond, VA.

Dr. Renwick's publications include his dissertation *Paul, the Temple and the Presence of God* (Scholars Press, 1991); *The Learning Bible*, contributing editor (American Bible Society, 2000); articles in *Interpretation, Biblical Preaching Journal*, and *Lectionary Homiletics*.

The Renwicks have served churches ranging in size from 17 members to 2500 members, in Labrador, Canada; Appomattox County, Virginia; San Antonio, Texas; Lexington, Kentucky and Spartanburg, South Carolina. Since 2011, Dr. Renwick has been Senior Pastor of The National Presbyterian Church, Washington, DC, and will be retiring in September.
