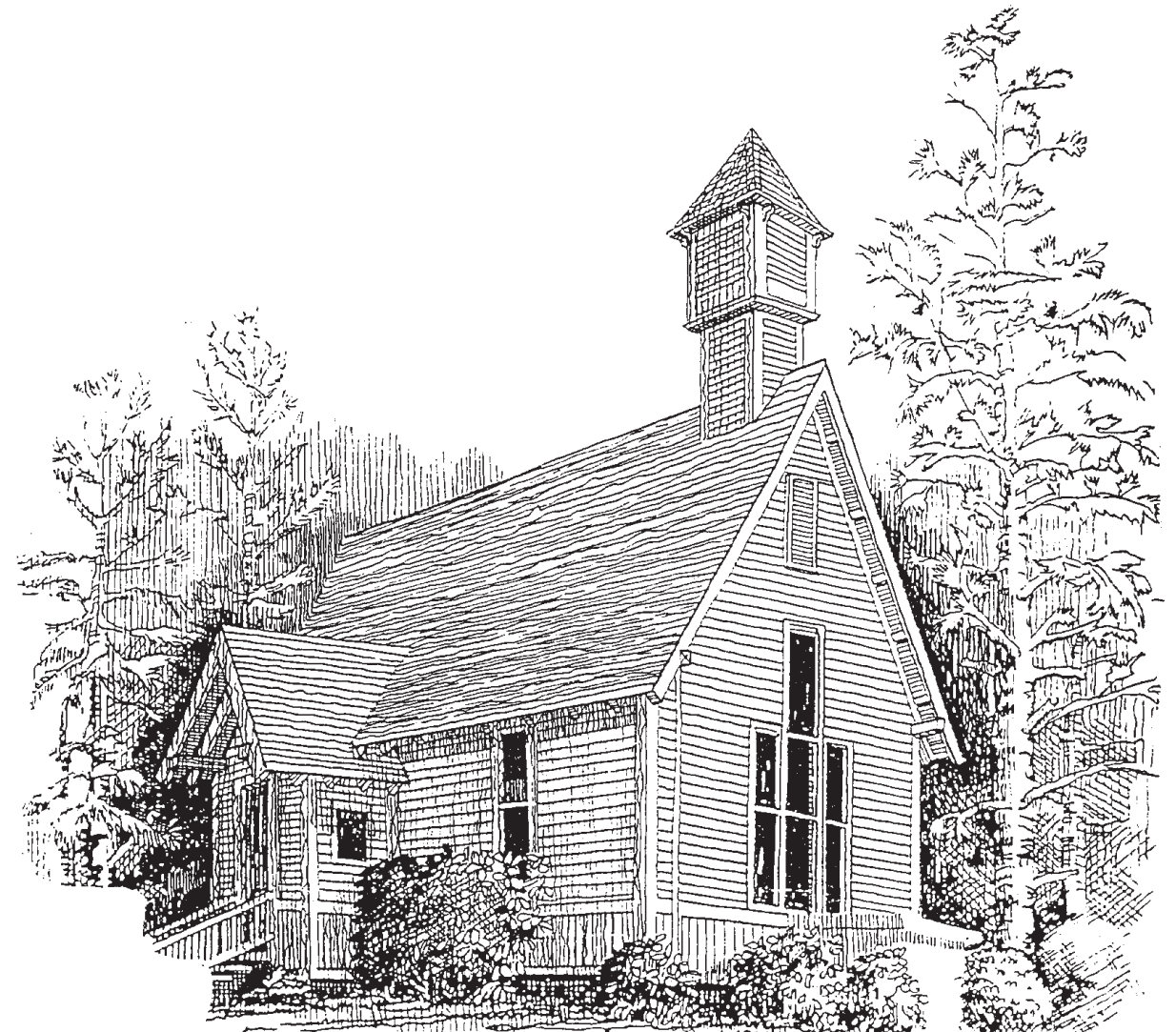
Thursday Morning Bible Study
