Outreach

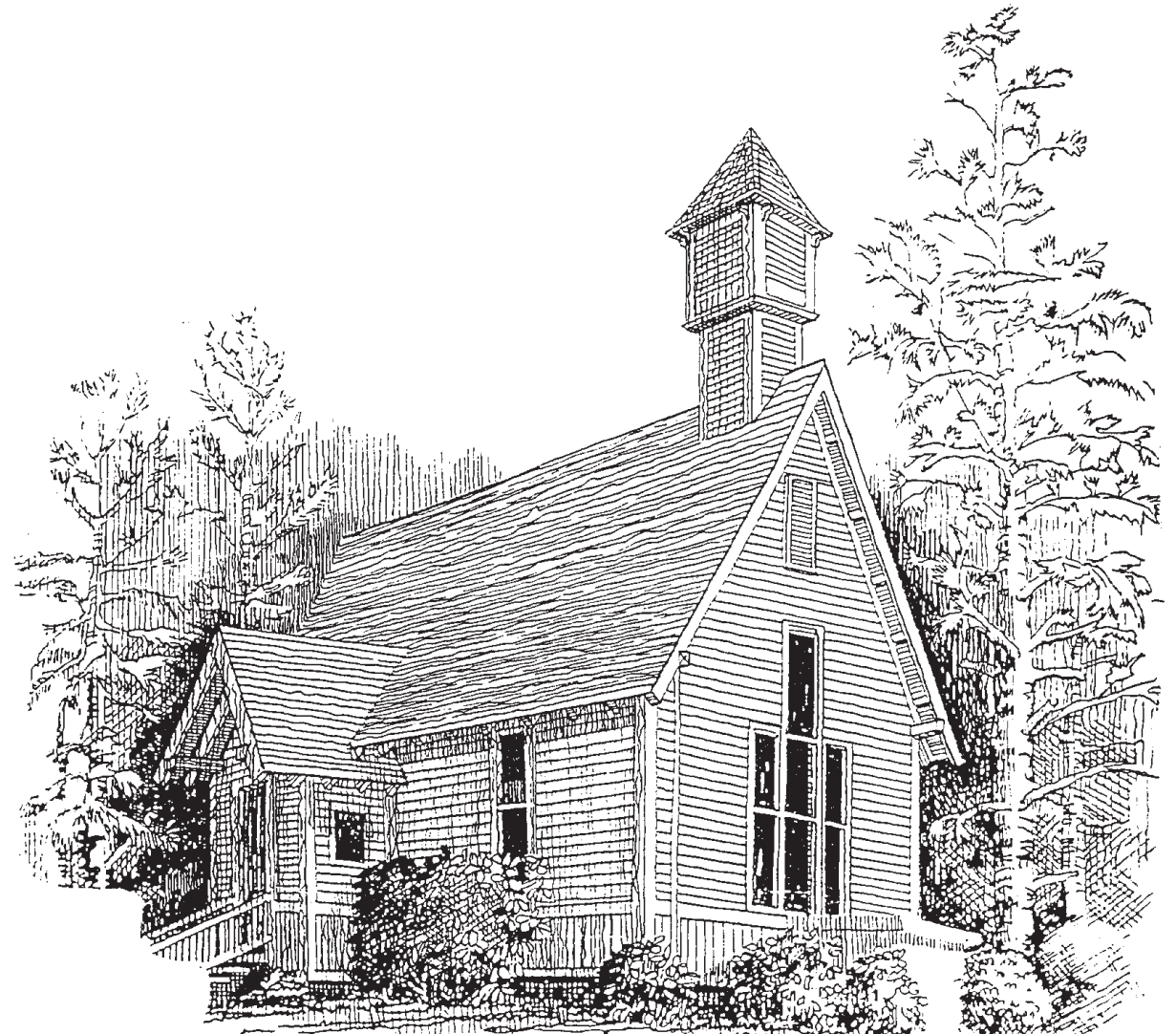
