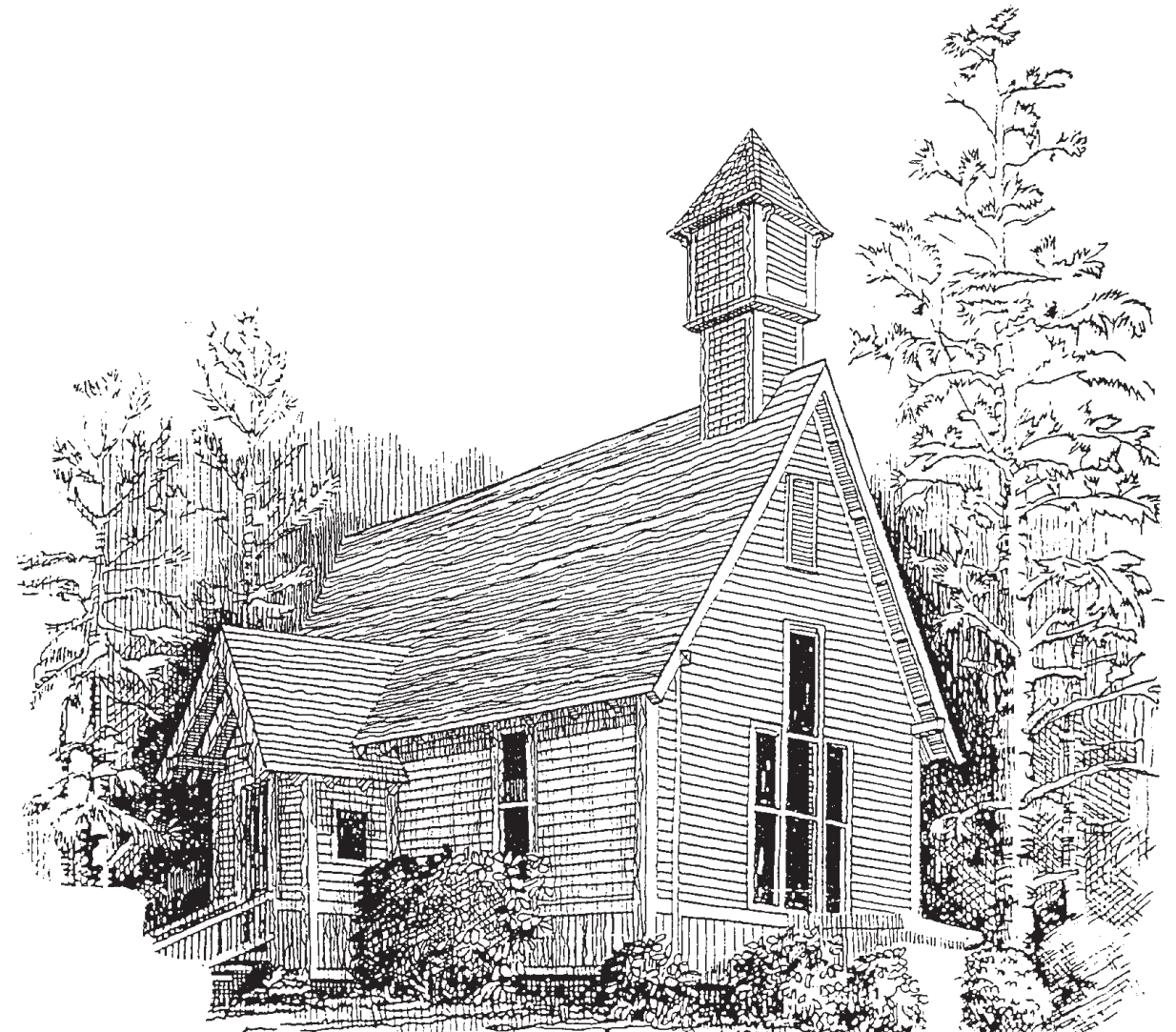
Outreach
