Outreach

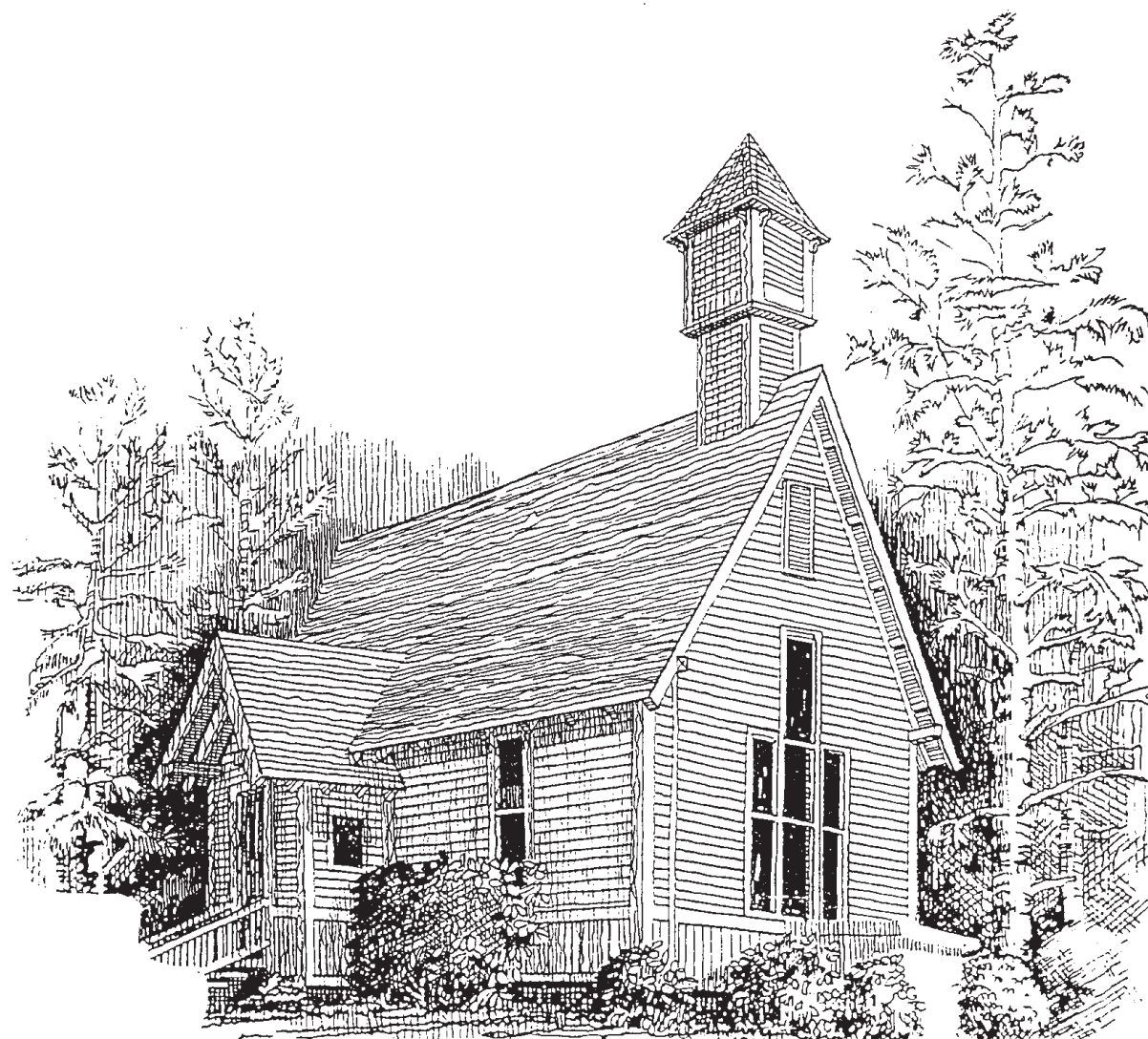
